Utopia Homelands Bed Delivery

Centrecorp Foundation is the Central Australia anchor partner for Goods on Country. Centrecorp funded the first Utopia Homelands bed batch in 2025, partnered on the May 2026 Central Australia deployment with Oonchiumpa and the Snow Foundation, and backs the six-month production plant trial that moves the making On Country. Young people build the Stretch Beds in Alice Springs, and local teams deliver them out to the homelands.

The next evidence step is linking delivery demand to Oonchiumpa and Central Australia capability.

WHAT WE MEASURE NEXT

HOUSEHOLD BENEFIT

Final bed count, household reach, direct people supported and follow-up needs.

HEALTH & COMFORT

Comfort, back pain, sleep, off-ground safety and whether the bed is still in use.

CIRCULAR ECONOMY

Recycled HDPE per bed, local feedstock potential, reparability and product lifespan.

VOICE & CONSENT

Three to five approved family, Elder, Oonchiumpa and delivery-partner voices.

PRODUCTION PATHWAY

Youth training hours, assembly time, local roles, facility readiness and maintenance issues.
